GOD IS SO GOOD

Several months ago, I was praying about my current situation, wondering if the Lord would allow me to move near my daughter and her family. The next day, I received a phone call from my daughter asking me to move to Connecticut to be close to my grandsons. I was floored. I did not expect God to answer my prayers so quickly.

I put my house on the market and received an offer on the first day. The movers took my belongings to Connecticut on January 8, and the contents were stored on January 15. I sold my house in New Orleans on February 5 and left for Connecticut on February 6. While in Connecticut, I will temporarily rent an apartment until the fall, when a condo will be ready for occupancy.

The location change will not change my work with CJFM. I will still be involved in outreach with the support of CJFM. However, I will also have the added support of Simchat Yisrael, a Messianic Jewish congregation located in West Haven, Connecticut. Upon my arrival, I hope to meet with the congregation's elders to see how I can help them reach more Jewish people for Yeshua (Jesus).

Simchat Yisrael is a wonderful place, and it will be a blessing to be with so many like-minded Jewish people again. I also look forward to participating in Israeli dance sessions at the Woodbridge Jewish Community Center and making new connections with people who do not know Messiah. Connecticut, whose Jewish population is 113,000, has eight times more Jewish people than Louisiana, which has a Jewish population of 14,000.

Before I left New Orleans. I attended the annual leadership conference of the Union of Messianic Jewish Congregations, where I led a Jewish tour of New Orleans. We visited the Hermann Grima House, previously owned by a German Jewish man who immigrated to New Orleans, and MS Rau Antiques, a famous store in the French Quarter owned and operated by a Jewish family since its inception. The tour ended with a visit to the Museum of the Southern Jewish Experience, which "explores the many ways that Jews in the American South influenced and were influenced by the distinct cultural heritage of their new homes. Through exhibits, collections, and programs focused on the unique and remarkable history of Southern Jews, the Museum encourages new understanding and appreciation for identity, diversity, and acceptance."
