UNLV Campus Outreach

This Fall semester, our campus ministry has been blessed with 34 salvations. Oanh has led most of those to the Lord, and we are seeing a dramatic attitude change in the students. Arguing over politics, evolution, etc., has been replaced with listening and asking questions about God. Please continue to pray for revival on campus as we approach the Spring semester. However, as you can see from the picture, Satan is alive and well on campus. This pro-Palestinian protest occurred just a few weeks before the shooting happened. They were chanting lies about Israel and the Jewish people. You can even see a sign that states, “From the river to the sea.” This means these protestors want the Palestinians to live in the land of Israel. But where do the Jewish people then live? That’s the question! If you ask a member of Hamas, they would want to wipe out every single Jewish person on Earth!



As the war continues in Israel against Hamas, the worst is yet to be realized. Israel is fighting on at least six fronts now, and anti-semitism has dramatically increased across the globe, especially here in the good ol’ US of A! Please pray for us in Las Vegas, where it is also growing.

I’m sure that you are aware of the shooting on the UNLV Campus on December 6. Our group of evangelists was on campus that morning, sharing the Gospel message of Jesus. As we walked to our cars to leave the campus, we passed by the Student Union and Beam Hall, where the business school meets for classes. We literally walked by the buildings five minutes before the shooting occurred! The shooter started his assault while we were driving away! We saw many police cars speeding by us, but we did not know why until a little later. It was reported that the shooter killed three teachers. As we grieve over all this evil, we praise the Lord for His protection. If the shooter had arrived

five minutes earlier, he could have shot one of us. We also realize that one of those business students that we shared Jesus with could have also been in that building while the shooting was going on! Just amazing! Please pray for our ministry and others on campus to be the agents for revival.

Michael and David

Michael and David started attending Beth Yeshua with their mother. We love to have visitors, especially children, so that we can share the Gospel with them both in the service and in the Shabbat school. The mother was a believer, but the children were not. Oanh started working with them right away, and Michael—the older brother—got saved. He jumped for joy like he had just scored the winning touchdown in the Superbowl! He came out of service and told his mother the good news. Rich also verified his

newfound faith in Jesus. However, his younger brother, David, did not want to do anything with Jesus. It turned out he was deaf, and Oanh had to talk with Michael, who signed with his brother. David rejected Jesus right away. But a few weeks later, after hearing more about Jesus, David also received Him as Lord and Savior! That's when Michael told us that they were Jewish because his father was Jewish! Well, praise the Lord for two Jewish boys believing in Jesus! They love our congregation and praising the Lord in the services! Please pray for their growth in the Lord and that they will be baptized! We are scheduling baptisms for the end of January.



Helping the Needy

Another aspect of our Gospel ministry is helping the needy. We are connected to a ministry that feeds the homeless and helps other needy folks as well. The Lord blessed our family with a beautiful bunk bed set so our girls could sleep in comfort. Since they are both married and moved out of town, we gave it to a needy family, as you can see in the picture. The boys were jumping for joy! Unfortunately, he contracted pancreatic cancer that also spread throughout his body. He fought the good fight but lost in the end. However, he only lost to the cancer. Before he died, Cameron told everyone that all he wanted to do was "To be with my Jesus!" Jesus answered that prayer, and we preached it at his funeral where one family member got saved!
